How to reset your password

Passwords are tricky to remember – we all forget them from time to time! But don't worry, you can reset your password (or set it for the first time, if you've never logged into the church website before) by following these instructions.

Step 1

Visit this page: <https://stpetersbirstall.co.uk/lost-password/>

You'll see this:

Lost password

If you've lost your password, or need to reset it, please enter your email address in the box below. You'll be sent an email containing a link that will allow you to reset your password.

If you have any problems with this please email chris@stillbreathing.co.uk and a friendly geek will assist you.

Email

Enter your email address and click 'Get new password. You'll see a message that says this:

Log in

- Check your email for the confirmation link.

Step 2

An email will be sent to you which says this (but with your username in):

St Peter's Church <help@stpetersbirstall.co.uk>
to me ▾

Someone has requested a password reset for the following account:

If this was a mistake, just ignore this email and nothing will happen.

Click the link in the email. It will open a web page.

Step 3

The web page that opens looks like this:

New password


Confirm new password

Hint: The password should be at least twelve characters long. To make it stronger, use upper and lower case letters, numbers, and symbols like ! * ? \$ % ^ &).

Enter your new password (twice!) following the instructions for making it strong. Click the 'Reset password' button.

You'll see a message saying that your password has been reset, like this:
